She has led a student-run, pre-concert lecture series, participated in a number of music festivals, and organized Benefit Concerts and Recital Hours.

As a conductor, Ms. Berger has attended the American String Teachers' Association's International Workshop in Stravanger, Norway and the Conductors Workshop of America at the University of Iowa. Currently, Ms. Berger teaches flute in the Wellesley Public Schools and works at the Danforth Art Museum.
